LICENSING REFORM –THE FINAL COUNTDOWN? Wednesday 19th January 4-6pm

The countdown to the new Licensing Act has begun. Westminster Council has now adopted its local policy and the Government has finalised the application forms, procedures and costs. Now all that is left is for you to apply for your new licences. D-Day is 7th February.

How much will it cost and how do you apply? Do you need new plans? What are the pitfalls and potential difficulties ahead? What are the actions you should be taking now? How will your business be viewed by the Council and what treatment can you expect?

Be the first to know the details of how policy will be applied on the ground in Westminster. Ensure you are best placed to take advantage of the new flexibilities and avoid costly mistakes by attending our next free members' event.
