Inspector Duncan Slade **Policing the new Licensing regime**

The countdown to the new Licensing Act has begun. Operators have only two more months to apply to convert their existing licences and the new regime will take effect from 24th November. From that date, Westminster Council and the Metropolitan Police will be responsible for inspecting your outlets and enforcing the new Licensing Act.
