We are now six months into the new licensing regime. Most licences are now in place and it is now down to the day-to-day business of making the new regime work. The police and City Council now have a major new role in inspecting all licensed premises and new powers to identify and tackle problem outlets.

With licence reviews, revocations and possible closures being talked about during licence inspections and in letters to licensees, how do you protect your business? What are the tests you need to satisfy? How are you being judged? What are the pitfalls and potential difficulties ahead? How can you make sure you are best placed to avoid costly mistakes?
